## Week 3 Plan to "Make It Stick"

**Day One:** (This interaction take place on Tues. or Wed. of Passion Week)

- -Read Matthew 26:6-13. (Jesus is Anointed at Bethany)
  - ⇒ What do you imagine this woman's actions meant to Jesus?
- ⇒ Are the disciples' objections surprising in any way? Do we ever think of other people's sacrificial gifts to Jesus as a "waste"?

<u>Day Two</u>: (These interactions take place on Thursday of Passion Week)

- -Read Matthew 26:14-25. (Jesus is grieved at Judas' coming betrayal)
  - ⇒ What is going on in Judas's head? How can his conscience allow him to interact with Jesus considering what he has planned?
  - ⇒ How has Jesus' mood shifted from earlier in Passion Week?

Day Three: (These interactions take place on Thursday of Passion Week)

- -Read Matthew 26:26-29. (Jesus institutes the Lord's Supper)
  - $\Rightarrow$  Do you think the disciples understood what Jesus was doing here?
  - ⇒ How does verse 29 tell you about what life will be like in the Father's kingdom?

<u>Day Four</u>: (These interactions take place on Thursday of Passion Week)

- -Read Matthew 26:30-35. (Jesus laments Peter's impending denials)
- ⇒ Was Peter wrong to say what he said in verse 35? What should he have said or done instead?
- ⇒ What emotions do you expect that Jesus is feeling as he interacts with Peter and the disciples in this paragraph?

Day Five: (These interactions take place on Thursday of Passion Week)

- -Read Matthew 26:40-41, 43-46.
  - ⇒ Why does Jesus wake up Peter, James, and John? Isn't He the one that is being tempted, not them?
  - ⇒ How is the Jesus of 26:45-46 different from the Jesus of 26:36-39? What made the difference, do you think?
