Generous Giving

2 Corinthians 9:6-15

Introduction: The principles of giving that flow out of the Corinthian context APPLY to us and HELP us UNDERSTAND and PRACTICE generous giving for the good of others and the glory of God!

Reasons for Generous Giving, 2 Cor 9:6-9	
☐ Givers REAP a Harvest, v. 6	
□ God LOVES a Cheerful Giver, v. 7	
□ God's Grace ABOUNDS to Givers, v. 8	
☐ Givers' Righteousness ENDURES Forever, v. 9	
□ Results of Generous Giving, 2 Cor 9:10-1	5

- MORE Seed for SOWING, vv. 10-11a
- □ SUPPLIES the Needs of the Saints, v. 12a

☐ THANKSGIVING to GOD, vv. 11b, 12b
□ GLORY to GOD, v. 13
□ PRAYER and AFFECTION for the GIVER, v. 14
□ POINTS to the GOSPEL, v. 15
Conclusion: God is a GENEROUS GIVER to GENEROUS GIVERS so that GENEROUS GIVERS can be EVEN MORE GENEROUS!
A Tool To Help:
☐ Create a Giving Plan. Have a plan to <u>start</u> giving, a plan to <u>maintain</u> giving, and a plan to <u>increase</u> giving.
☐ Measure your giving by <u>Personal Ability</u> more than Rigid Percentage (e.g., tithe).
□ Consider giving from Gross and not Net. Give to God first!
