## A Father's Discipline

Hebrews 12:5-11

**Big Idea:** If God is your Dad, your training will include \_\_\_\_\_! (Hebrews 12:5-6)

**What does THAT mean?** It's used in 3 ways...

⇒ Generally to refer to the \_\_\_\_\_ of children.  
(Ephesians 6:4, Acts 7:22, Acts 22:3)

⇒ More narrowly to suggest \_\_\_\_\_ instruction and guidance. (2 Timothy 3:16, Titus 2:11-12)

⇒ Most common usage: to introduce \_\_\_\_\_ to correct \_\_\_\_\_ - \_\_\_\_\_. (1 Timothy 1:19b-20, 2 Timothy 2:24-25a, 1 Corinthians 11:29-32a, Hebrews 12:5-6)

So, how should we respond to discipline?

- \_\_\_\_\_ what's going on.
  - Discipline is NOT a sign of \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_. (Hebrews 12:5)
  - Discipline IS \_\_\_\_\_ that God \_\_\_\_\_ you. (Hebrews 12:6, Revelation 3:19)

  - God is \_\_\_\_\_ you to be like Him. (Hebrews 12:10-11)
- \_\_\_\_\_ your discipline from God. (Hebrews 12:9)
- \_\_\_\_\_ this discipline to keep \_\_\_\_\_. (Hebrews 12:12-14)
